Councilor Dante Pajo Honored Guest at GsK Dinner

Hon. Dante Pajo was the honored guest during the Dinner with a Purpose. As the former Chairperson of the Sangguniang Kabataan in Cagayan de Oro from 1986 -1992, he was immersed in the predicament of the youth and children. In his speech, he underscored the need to support and protect the street children. He happily informed the community that a new financial assistance from the city government in the amount of eight hundred thousand pesos (Php 800,000.00) is allotted for the street children in the city. Hon. Pajo is a newly elected Councilor of Cagayan de Oro City and Chairperson of Committee on Health and Social Services.

Dinner with a Purpose becomes a traditional advocacy activity of GsK. In November 23, 2007 Gugma sa Kabataan Executive Director Iluminada Domingo, presented the programs and services that benefits the street children who are in custody of GsK. The thirty four (34) kids are victims of poverty, dysfunctional family and neglect. Also, it was an opportunity to market their art works and crafts like fashion apparels, batik shirt prints, water color painting and all occasion cards. The objective to be self-reliant is slowly being achieved by thirty (30) clients who invested on savings at First Community Cooperative (FICCO).

The Meeting of the East and the West

The meeting of the east and the west was an opportunity of a "teaching-learning" experience. International volunteers Bernhardt, Wilke and Godinez were moved to tears as the children bids farewell to them. On the other hand, GsK Kids will always cherish the patience, kindness, care and concern expressed by the volunteers in teaching them particularly on Communication Arts in English and Mathematics.

The three (3) international volunteers came at different times at GsK. Ms. Angela Godinez came in June for a month voluntary work teaching GsK kids in English. While on a school vacation it is her goal to do something BIG before she graduated from the university. Ms. Godinez is pursuing a 4th-8th degree on Education at the Houston University is expected to received her Bachelors degree this March 2008.

Mr. Philipp Bernhardt has his ways of teaching and learning as a volunteer in GsK. Coming from a family of artist in the field of music, he is gifted in "hip-hop." For almost two (2) months immersion with GsK, he enhanced the skills of the kids in rap music. On the other hand, he listened from few GsK kids whose pain and suffering as a victim of neglect and poverty were expressed in rap. The production of promotional material, e.g. GsK CD presentation, has been his contribution to advocate the program of GsK. His being a traveled youth from the continent of Europe, Asia and Africa has motivated him to study a degree on non-government organization in developing countries.

After two (2) years of school work in Germany, Mr. Albrecht Wilke is back to GsK. Mr. Wilke is working on his doctoral dissertation Case Study of Street Children in the Philippines: Gugma sa Kabataan, Inc. In August 2002, Mr. Wilke came to gather data from GsK clients. During his visit in August 8 - 31, 2007, the GsK respondents on his case study where moved to tears from the questioned asked different from 2002. He asked them to sing a song of joy and to draw a picture of a happy family. It was too difficult for Lito to sing a song of joy when until now he remains in Boys Town - alone and no family to turn to. His visit was beyond his paper work. GsK children in need of medical assistance were brought to German Doctors Hospital.

The wall that divides of the so called "First and Third World" has been broken. International volunteers – Angela, Philipp and Albrecht in their own unique way have come to be a part in the giving of life to the children of Gugma sa Kabataan.

Ten (10) benefactors pledged for the monthly fresh milk supply and one (1) time cash gift of two hundred pesos (Php 200.00) per child. Let us commend Seniors Student from Liceo de Cagayan University. On the Job Training (OJT) students from Liceo de Cagayan University in the College of Education and Department of Behavioral Science were immersed in the community learning service at GsK. Twenty-one (21) student teachers in the Secondary and Elementary Education have performed very well during the 1st semester of SY 2007-2008,. Another five (5) psychology students were of great help in the psychological assessment of those clients having psychological needs and problems.

Hon. Ebabacol Supports GsK

In two (2) different occasions Hon. Jericho Goldmar Ebabacol has expressed support to GsK. During the City accreditation process, Hon Ebabacol has vouched that GsK has met the standards required by the City Planning Committee. Secondly, he strongly recommended GsK to local benefactors who have the heart to support street children.

Hon. Ebabacol is newly appointed as the Youth Consultant in the City of Cagayan. As an outgoing Chairman of Sanguniang Kabataan in the City of Cagayan, he was instrumental in putting up a Center for the young people and to protect the children and youth on drug problem in the city.

Also, he served as Chairman of Sanguniang Kabataan in his own Barangay 17 where GsK belongs.

Abellanosa A Pilot Community for Development

Gugma sa Kabataan, Inc. (GsK) launched a livelihood program in Abellanosa (Brgy 17) for community development. A trisikad (three wheel bicycle) unit on GsK livelihood program -"Rent to Own" is acquired to help unemployed parent to earn for a living. For a period of seven (7) months it will be rented out daily for a minimal daily fee of Php 30.00. On the 8th month GsK ownership will be turned over to the tenant.

Edwin and Joy Bagajo are the parents of client Vincent. Joy is underemployed while husband Edwin is unemployed. Like most of the families in Abellanosa area the children were out of school youth. GsK client Vincent is the 4th child of 8th siblings who quit schooling for four years.

GsK have chosen Abellanosa area in Brgy 17 as a partner in community development. For three salient reasons: a) twenty-three percent (23%) Gsk clients are coming from Abellanosa b) perceived high in social problems e.g prostitution due to poverty ; and c) GsK belongs to Brgy. 17.

GsK Staff Trainings and Professional Development

Two (2) GsK staff has participated in trainings to hone the skills and keep abreast on the current issues as a Non-Government Organization. A seminar on R.A. 9344, Juvenile Justice Welfare Act sponsored by Cagayan de Oro Task Force Especially for in Difficult Circumstances Children (CDTFECDC). Fiscal Eldred Cole was the honored facilitator who explained fully the expectations and responsibilities of government and non-government agencies on Juvenile Justice Welfare act. GsK Executive Director, Iluminada SA. Domingo participated on the said seminar.

Toast masters International Oro in Cagayan de Oro convened a Seminar Workshop on Speech Development at Dynasty Hotel in October 20, 2007. Ms. Kathleen Ann Mercado-Castillon, GsK Technical Assistant and Bookkeeper were one of the selected few of twenty (20) participants. Ms. Castillon acknowledged the tough training yet rewarding for her skill enhancement as a front liner in the office.
