SUMMERTIME FOR STUDENTS IN BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE

The department of behavioral Science in two universities – Ateneo and Central Mindanao State University provides services to address the psychological needs of the children. In the months of March to May, the two universities have worked hand in hand with Ggugma sa kabataan, to identify the psychological needs of the children. The students who are on their junior year in the University have to complete 80 to 120 hours as school requirements, submit a case study to earn a degree in psychology.

The involvement of the students have helped to provide sense of worth and belonging to the children. Also, the case studies have identified the trauma, hatred, depression and other pent up emotions from which the children suffered as victims. On the otherhand, the students are deeply grateful to the children who from the circumstances they are into have provided them the opportunity to reconcile the theory into the actual world. Also, the children have empowered the students on their resiliency as victims of neglect, abused and abandonment.
